CODE OF CONDUCT FOR FACULTY

- 1. A teacher should be involved in extension, co curricular and extracurricular activities including the community services.
- 2. A teacher should strive for continued professional development through study and research.
- 3. A teacher shall have a freedom of thought and expression. He shall not misuse the facilities or forum of the College/ University.
- 4. A teacher shall not refuse to carry out the academic and administrative decision taken by the Principal/Governing body.
- 5. A teacher shall perform his academic duties and work related to examinations as assigned.
- 6. Treat all students with love and affection and be just and impartial to all irrespective of caste, creed, sex, status, religion, language and place of birth.
- 7. A teacher shall not indulge in, directly or indirectly, any malpractice or unfair means in teaching or examination/ administration.
- 8. A teacher shall not furnish incorrect information regarding his qualifications, age, etc. in respect of his appointment/promotion.
- 9. Your behaviour and professional conduct must set a good example to all students.
- 10. Avoid using inappropriate or offensive language.
- 11. Guide the students in their physical, social, intellectual, emotional, moral and spiritual development
- 12. Take notice of the individual needs and differences among students in their socio-cultural background and adapt his/ her teaching accordingly.
- 13. There should be regular interactions with the guardians of the students as this is necessary for the improvement of the students and the Institution.
